New Test Results for Potholes Reservoir Available Warning Signs are Being Removed Today

New test results are now available for blue-green algae toxin levels in Potholes Reservoir. For the second consecutive week, all samples were found to have toxin levels **below** the Washington State Recreational Guidelines.

The samples were gathered on August 29 at Lind Coulee and Potholes State Park.

All warning signs will be removed today, September 1.

The Grant County Health District reminds users of all bodies of fresh water to avoid areas of algae and to contact the Health District at (509) 754-6060 if algae is found.
