Washington's new HIV service delivery system



Open Community Forum in Yakima

Department of Health staff are conducting a statewide listening tour to gather community input on development of the new HIV planning structure and delivery system for Care and Prevention.

Engrossed House Bill 2360 eliminates the AIDSNETS HIV service delivery system on January 1, 2011. This legislation presents Washington HIV service providers and stakeholders with a unique opportunity to update HIV care and prevention service delivery for the next 20 years.

Key themes:

- Maximize service delivery to clients in an era of diminishing resources
- Reframe public health response to HIV/AIDS to more efficiently serve the state's populations
- Reinvigorate efforts to reduce new HIV infections and to ensure persons living with HIV are provided with quality care and treatment services
- Leverage effective practices and relationships
