

Add Immunizations to Your 2010 Back-to-School Checklist



Vaccines for all children

- 3 doses of Hepatitis B
- 5 doses of DTap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
- 4 doses of Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type b)
- 4 doses of PCV (Pneumococcal)
- 4 doses of IPV (Inactivated Poliovirus)
- 2 doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- 2 doses of Varicella (Chicken pox)
- 2 doses of Hepatitis A
- 1 dose of Influenza yearly

Vaccines for adolescents

- 3 doses of HPV (Human Papillomavirus) when student is 9 yrs. or older.
- 1 dose of Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) when student is 11 yrs. or older.
- 1 dose of MCV4 (Meningococcal) when student is 11 yrs. or older.

Parents do your homework and contact your student's health care provider today and schedule an immunization appointment.
